## PROGRAMS

The College of Technology Management at National Tsing Hua University located in Hsinchu of Taiwan offers International Master of Business Administration (IMBA) program leading to a master's degree. IMBA program is a full-time two-year MBA program. We encourage applications from all qualified persons interested in the study of management. Individuals holding a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university who have at least two years working experiences are eligible for consideration. Prior study in business or economics is not a requirement for admission. In the first year, students complete a rigorous core curriculum consisting of several required courses that provides a background for advanced, specialized work in academic majors and professional fields. Each student pursues an internship during the summer following the first year. In the second year, in addition to the master thesis which is required, students have the freedom to elect their courses and typically major in two or three areas. The courses are offered in English by the faculty of University System of Taiwan (UST). The UST system, consisting of National Tsing Hua University in Hsinchu, National Chiao Tung University in Hsinchu, National Central University in Jhongli and National Yang-Ming University in Taipei, has the advantage in providing variety of courses to match the needs for the different specialized professional programs.

## APPLICATION

Sixteen domestic applicants and roughly the same amount of foreign applicants are expected to be admitted as IMBA students in Fall 2007. To be considered for admission, candidates must submit a complete application, which includes all supporting documents. The supporting documents depend on the status of the applicants.

### DOMESTIC APPLICANTS

Citizen of Taiwan, Republic of China holding a bachelor's degree to be considered for admission, candidates

must submit

- personal information form both in English and Chinese.
- photocopy of the original bachelor's degree diploma.
- certification of working experiences.
- official academic transcripts
- TOEFL score
- two recommendation letters.
- study plan in English
- application fee NT\$1,300

Upon receiving the applicant's complete supporting documents, the Admissions Committee evaluates each applicant's qualification and assess his or her candidacy compared to the overall pool of applicants. After the preliminarily screening process, only selected applicants will be invited for an on-campus interview for further consideration of admission. The interview will be held in English. ### INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

Students applying for Taiwan International Cooperation and Development Fund (ICDF) scholarship in IMBA in Technology Management Program must submit the application directly to ICDF and use the application form provided by ICDF (<http://www.icdf.org.tw/>).

Other Non-Taiwan, Republic of China citizens must apply via Division of International and Continuing Education, National Tsing Hua University. ## APPLICATION COMPONENTS

### EVALUATIVE INTERVIEWS

The Admissions Committee requires every domestic applicant who has passed the preliminary data evaluation to attend an evaluative personal interview. The interview is in English and is an important element in evaluating an applicant's level of maturity, interpersonal skills, career focus and motivation. However, the interview is only one criterion used in the admission decision. All personal interviews are held in Hsinchu campus on the same day. The qualified candidates will be notified of on-campus interview arrangement via email. On-campus interview is not required but is encouraged for the international applicants. We may arrange off-campus interviews for applicants from abroad if possible.

### ACADEMIC TRANSCRIPT

Official academic transcripts from all colleges, universities and professional schools previously or currently attended are required. Transcripts are examined not only for the grade point average, but also for trends and areas of particular scholastic strength. Please submit the official academic transcript in a signed and sealed university envelope.

### GMAT (GRADUATE MANAGEMENT ADMISSION TEST)

All international applicants are required to submit a valid GMAT score; scores are valid for 5 years from the application deadline to which you are applying. GMAT is not required but is encouraged for domestic applicants. Information about the GMAT is available at mba.com. The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) is not accepted.

### TOEFL (TEST OF ENGLISH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE)

Proficiency in reading, writing and speaking English is required. Classes and group work require strong English language skills. A valid score for the TOEFL is

required for both domestic and international applicants whose native language is not English AND who have not received a university degree in one of the following countries: Australia, Canada (not including Quebec), England, Ireland, New Zealand, Scotland, South Africa, the United States and Wales. TOEFL scores are valid for two years.

### RECOMMENDATION LETTER

Two completed letters of recommendation are required for admission. One of your letters of recommendation should be written by your current supervisor or manager. The second letter of recommendation also should be from someone who can objectively evaluate your professional performance as well as managerial and leadership potential, such as a former supervisor, previous employer, previous professor, client, etc. Letters of recommendations in Chinese are also accepted.

Your recommender should enclosed the evaluation form and any additional pages in the confidential envelope, seal and sign across the flap of the envelope, and return it to you. Return the envelope unopened with your application.

### APPLICATION FEE

Applications require the submission of a nonrefundable fee of NT\$1,300 for domestic students. The application is free for the international students. This fee must be paid in the form of post office draft and made payable to National Tsing Hua University.

## TUITION AND COSTS

IMBA program in NTHU is a two-year full time graduate program. The base tuition is NT\$22,160 per year and NT\$1,580 per course credit taken. The estimated tuition is about NT\$63,240 (exchange rate is about US\$1=NT\$33)

On-campus housing expense ranges from NT\$15,000 to NT\$30,000 per year for a single person. There is no on-campus family housing available. The rent for off-campus one-bedroom apartment ranges from NT\$100,000 to NT\$200,000 per year. A regular on-campus meal costs from NT\$50 to NT\$100.

## FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

Educational loans and scholarships are available to all domestic students. There are some scholarships eligible for most foreign students. One of them is Taiwan International Cooperation and Development Fund Scholarship in IMBA in Technology Management Program (<http://www.icdf.org.tw/>). The other is Taiwan Scholarship Program offered by the Ministry of Education, Republic of China (<http://www.moe.gov.tw>).
